My name is Steve Shamion and I live in Post Falls. I am also the President of the Spokane River Association, representing approximately 200 waterfront property owners in Coeur d' Alene and Post Falls, Idaho.

Earlier today, our Board of Directors were informed about new legislation, recently passed through by the Panhandle Health District. I'm specifically referring to the drainfield requirement, which is now based on square footage, instead of number of bedrooms in a home. We were also informed that this legislation only applies to the five districts in North Idaho, and not statewide. It is our further understanding that you are taking action in an attempt to reverse this legislation, which would return it to the original requirement based on number of bathrooms.

The Spokane River Association's Board of Directors voted unanimously to support you in this effort. Please advise if we can be of further assistance.
